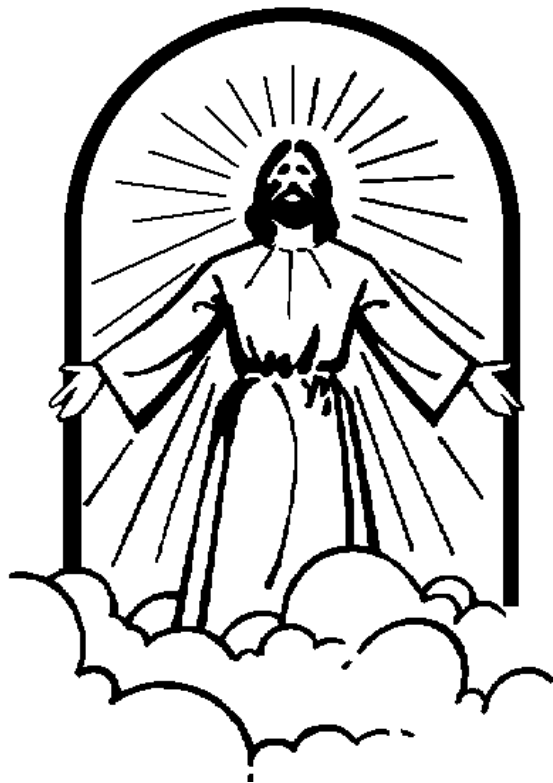

“But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.”

A Service Of Word & Sacrament, setting 2 (page 12, Worship Supplement)

FIRST LESSON: Isaiah 61:1-3

¹ The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *those who are bound*; ² to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn, ³ to console those who mourn in Zion, to give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified.

Responsive Reading from Psalm 119:1ff.

L: Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the LORD!

C: BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO KEEP HIS TESTIMONIES, WHO SEEK HIM WITH THE WHOLE HEART!

L: Oh, that my ways were directed to keep Your statutes!

C: WITH MY WHOLE HEART I HAVE SOUGHT YOU; OH, LET ME NOT WANDER FROM YOUR COMMANDMENTS!

L: Your Word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You!

C: BLESSED ARE YOU, O LORD! TEACH ME YOUR STATUTES!

L: I have rejoiced in the way of Your testimonies, as much as in all riches.

C: I WILL MEDITATE ON YOUR PRECEPTS, AND CONTEMPLATE YOUR WAYS.

L: I will delight myself in Your statutes; I will not forget Your Word.

C: OPEN MY EYES, THAT I MAY SEE WONDROUS THINGS FROM YOUR LAW.

SECOND LESSON – the Gospel: Luke 4:14-21 *rise*

¹⁴ Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region. ¹⁵ And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified by all. ¹⁶ So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. ¹⁷ And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: ¹⁸ “The Spirit of the LORD *is* upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the Gospel to *the poor*; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,

to proclaim liberty to *the* captives and recovery of sight to *the* blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; ¹⁹ to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.” ²⁰ Then He closed the book, and gave *it* back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. ²¹ And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.”

³ But even if our Gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, ⁴ whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the Gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. ... ⁶ For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.
