

The Order Of The Confessional Service, pages 46-48 (The Lutheran Hymnal)

FIRST LESSON: Isaiah 49:1-6

¹ "Listen, O coastlands, to Me, and take heed, you peoples from afar! The LORD has called Me from the womb; from the matrix of My mother He has made mention of My name. ² And He has made My mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of His hand He has hidden Me, and made Me a polished shaft; in His quiver He has hidden Me." ³ And He said to me, "You are My servant, O Israel, in whom I will be glorified." ⁴ Then I said, "I have labored in vain, I have spent My strength for nothing and in vain; yet surely My just reward is with the LORD, and My work with My God." ⁵ And now the LORD says, Who formed Me from the womb to be His Servant, to bring Jacob back to Him, so that Israel is gathered to Him (for I shall be glorious in the eyes of the LORD, and My God shall be My strength), ⁶ indeed He says, "It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, that You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth."

PSALM OF THE DAY (responsively) – Psalm 67

M: God be merciful to us and bless us, and cause His face to shine upon us.

C: THAT YOUR WAY MAY BE KNOWN ON EARTH, YOUR SALVATION AMONG ALL NATIONS.

M: Let the peoples praise You, O God; let all the peoples praise You.

C: OH, LET THE NATIONS BE GLAD AND SING FOR JOY!

M: For You shall judge the people righteously, and govern the nations on earth.

C: LET THE PEOPLES PRAISE YOU, O GOD; LET ALL THE PEOPLES PRAISE YOU.

M: Then the earth shall yield her increase; God, our own God, shall bless us.

C: GOD SHALL BLESS US, AND ALL THE ENDS OF THE EARTH SHALL FEAR HIM.

SECOND LESSON : Ephesians 5:1-16 *rise*

¹ Therefore be imitators of God as dear children. ² And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma. ³ But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you, as is fitting for saints; ⁴ neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks. ⁵ For this you know, that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. ⁶ Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience. ⁷ Therefore do not be partakers with them. ⁸ For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light ⁹ (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), ¹⁰ finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. ¹¹ And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them. ¹² For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret. ¹³ But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light. ¹⁴ Therefore He says: "Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light." ¹⁵ See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, ¹⁶ redeeming the time, because the days are evil.
